design and type of analysis The final stage involves the extraction of relevant quantita-tive and/or qualitative data, in order to synthesise the evidence Depending on the field, a meta-analysis is often used to combine and directly compare quantitative results Systematic reviews are usually peer-reviewed at different stages in the process
